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## Keep Being You

#### You are unlike any other. And HIV doesn't change that.

When taken as prescribed, HIV treatment can help you get to and stay undetectable, so **you can keep being yourself**.

Today's medicines have helped people live healthy with HIV. While there is no cure for HIV, finding a treatment that's right for you can help suppress the virus. Don't wait to talk to your healthcare provider. Talk about your treatment options as soon as you are diagnosed.

#### Taking HIV medicine as prescribed helps the body fight HIV.

- HIV medicines can lower the amount of virus in the blood to levels
  that are undetectable. That means the amount of virus is so low it can't
  be measured in a lab test.
- Lowering the amount of virus in the blood helps increase CD4 T-cells (the number of cells that fight infections in the body), strengthening the immune system.



Take BIKTARVY exactly as your healthcare provider tells you to take it, and do not miss a dose. Do not change your dose or stop taking BIKTARVY without first talking with your healthcare provider.

BIKTARVY is a prescription medicine for adults and children with HIV-1 who weigh at least 31 lbs and who are either:

- ◆ new to HIV-1 treatment OR ◆ replacing their current regimen
- ◆ For adults and children replacing their current regimen, their healthcare provider must determine if they meet certain requirements, including having an undetectable viral load (less than 50 copies/mL)

BIKTARVY does not cure HIV-1 or AIDS. HIV is the virus that causes AIDS.


Children weighing at least 31 pounds to less than 55 pounds take a lowerdose tablet of BIKTARVY containing 30 mg bictegravir, 120 mg emtricitabine, and 15 mg tenofovir alafenamide once daily with or without food.

Sometimes HIV can change or mutate. This change might make your medicines not work as well. **This is called a** *resistance mutation* **or** *treatment resistance.* It's important to understand resistance and what it means for your HIV treatment.

## Starting HIV Treatment

When you're diagnosed with HIV, it's important to start treatment right away.

According to the US Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS), many patients can get to undetectable in as quickly as 8 to 24 weeks when taking their treatment as prescribed. **Some people are even able to start treatment the same day as diagnosis.** 

An HIV treatment, when taken as prescribed, may reduce the amount of HIV in the body to an undetectable level. Being undetectable can help you live healthy with HIV.



#### WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN STARTING TREATMENT

Some patients may be able to start BIKTARVY® right away. Before starting treatment, your healthcare provider will perform some tests to make sure it's the right fit for your needs. These tests will include:


- Testing for hepatitis B
- Determining if your HIV is resistant to any medications
- Checking your CD4 count
- Measuring the amount of HIV virus in your blood

Talk to your healthcare provider about whether you may be able to start BIKTARVY right away, even the same day as your diagnosis. Starting HIV-1 treatment is an important decision. Your healthcare provider will help determine if BIKTARVY is right for you.



#### **Important Reminders:**

- Do not change your dose or stop taking BIKTARVY without first talking with your healthcare provider
- Stay under a healthcare provider's care when taking BIKTARVY



#### **UNDERSTANDING TYPES OF TREATMENTS**

How different types of HIV medicines work together to fight the virus.

#### **Drug classes**

HIV medicines are grouped into different drug classes according to how they fight HIV. Complete HIV treatment regimens combine more than one drug class to fight HIV.

#### Integrase strand inhibitor (INSTI)

INSTI is a class of drugs used to fight HIV at a certain part of the HIV life cycle. **BIKTARVY** is the only treatment containing the INSTI bictegravir.

#### Single-tablet regimen (STR)

A single-tablet regimen is a treatment for HIV where all the medicines you need are combined into one pill.

BIKTARVY® is the only INSTI-based STR recommended by DHHS guidelines for a same-day start for those who meet certain requirements.



 ◆ rifampin
 ◆ any other medicines to treat HIV-1

#### What are the other possible side effects of BIKTARVY?

Serious side effects of BIKTARVY may also include:

• Changes in your immune system. Your immune system may get stronger and begin to fight infections that may have been hidden in your body. Tell your healthcare provider if you have any new symptoms after you start taking BIKTARVY.



#### **Study 1844 | 3 years**



#### **RESULTS**

**At 1 year, about 9 out of 10 people** (94%, 264 out of 282) who were undetectable on another treatment **stayed undetectable when they switched to BIKTARVY** in clinical trials. Of the people who continued their current treatment, about 9 out of 10 (95%, 267 out of 281) stayed undetectable at 1 year.

**Both 1-year and 3-year** time points showed that most adults who replaced their current treatment with BIKTARVY and took their treatment as prescribed **stayed undetectable**.


• Severe liver problems, which in rare cases can lead to death. The most common side effects of BIKTARVY in clinical studies were diarrhea (6%), nausea (6%), and headache (5%). Tell your healthcare provider if you have any side effects that bother you or don't go away.

#### **RESULTS**

**At 1 year, about 9 out of 10 people** (92%, 267 out of 290) who were undetectable on another treatment **stayed undetectable when they switched to BIKTARVY** in clinical trials. Of the people who continued their current treatment, about 9 out of 10 (89%, 255 out of 287) stayed undetectable at 1 year.

**Both 1-year and 2-year** time points showed that most adults who replaced their current treatment with BIKTARVY and took their treatment as prescribed **stayed undetectable**.



## **Defending** Against Resistance Matters

Taking medicine with a high barrier to resistance and sticking to your treatment can help defend against developing drug resistance.

#### WHAT IS RESISTANCE?

Sometimes, HIV can change or mutate. This change might make a medicine not work as well. This is called a *resistance mutation* or *treatment resistance*. When HIV becomes resistant, it's tougher to treat. Resistance is permanent and not reversible, which means future treatment options could be limited. That's why it's important to understand ways to reduce the risk of resistance.

#### **HOW DOES HIV BECOME RESISTANT?**

- From the start: When someone acquires HIV, it is possible that the HIV
  virus is already resistant to certain medicines. This is called "preexisting
  resistance," and it means some treatments won't work even before they are
  used.
- Over time: If HIV changes after treatment starts, it can become resistant
  and affect how well the treatment works. Your viral load can increase if
  you don't take your HIV medicines as prescribed, if you miss doses, or if
  you stop treatment. This is one way you can develop drug resistance.

Make sure to take your treatment as prescribed because low levels of medicine in your blood may make it easier for the HIV virus to mutate or change.

#### The Importance of a High Barrier to Resistance

Medicines have low to high barriers to resistance, which tell us how many mutations would need to occur to stop the medicine from working. A medicine with a high barrier to resistance means it can still work even after several mutations. An important defense against drug resistance is choosing a treatment with a high barrier to resistance and taking it exactly as your healthcare provider prescribes.

Make sure to discuss resistance with your healthcare provider.

They can help you understand why barriers to resistance matter.

# Can Keep Morking Even if HIV Has Changed

#### BIKTARVY® was proven to keep working in clinical trials even when HIV has changed in certain ways.

One BIKTARVY study involved more than 560 adults, some of who had an HIV virus with a resistance mutation called M184V/I.

- People in the study either switched or continued their current treatment.
   284 switched treatment with BIKTARVY, and 281 stayed on or switched their treatment with DESCOVY® (emtricitabine, tenofovir alafenamide) + TIVICAY® (dolutegravir) over a 1-year period.
- ◆ Of the adults who switched to BIKTARVY, 47 out of 284 had an HIV virus that had changed in a certain way (a mutation called M184V/I) so that it was resistant to emtricitabine, a medicine in BIKTARVY.

BIKTARVY can help adults stay undetectable whose virus has changed in a certain way (a mutation called M184V/I), where it is resistant to emtricitabine, a medicine in BIKTARVY. Before taking BIKTARVY, your healthcare provider must determine that you meet certain requirements.

## An Established Safety Profile

### OF ADULTS NEW TO TREATMENT STOPPED TAKING BIKTARVY® DUE TO RELATED SIDE EFFECTS#


- ◆ Less than 1% of adults new to treatment who initially started on BIKTARVY at the beginning of the clinical trials stopped taking BIKTARVY because of related side effects through 5 years.
- In clinical trials of adults living with HIV who were new to treatment and initially started on BIKTARVY in the beginning of the clinical trials, no one stopped taking BIKTARVY due to bone-, kidney-, or liver-related side effects through 5 years.

Of the patients who initially started on BIKTARVY at the beginning of the clinical trials, the most common side effects of BIKTARVY through 5 years, experienced in at least 5% of people in either study, were diarrhea, headache, and nausea.

Overall, the safety profile in clinical trials for people who switched to BIKTARVY, including those with the M184V/I mutation, was similar to that of people who were new to BIKTARVY.

These are not the only side effects of BIKTARVY. Tell your healthcare provider if you experience any side effects that bother you or do not go away.

\*The side effects, also known as adverse events related to BIKTARVY that led patients to stop taking BIKTARVY over the 5-year studies were: weight gain; chest pain; bloating; sleep disorder, indigestion, tension headache, depressed mood, and insomnia; depression.







## Understanding Possible Side Effects

The most common side effects of BIKTARVY® in clinical studies through 3 years were each experienced in at least 5% of people. In clinical studies of 634 adults new to HIV-1 treatment, the most common side effects were nausea (6%), diarrhea (6%), and headache (5%). These common side effects were each experienced by at least 1 out of 20 people ( $\geq$ 5%).

BIKTARVY® can affect the way other medicines work, and other medicines can affect how BIKTARVY works, which may cause serious side effects. Some medicines may also make the amount of BIKTARVY in your body too low to help keep your HIV-1 undetectable, and the virus may become resistant to BIKTARVY.

#### What should I tell my healthcare provider before taking BIKTARVY®?

- Tell your healthcare provider your health history and if you have or have had any kidney or liver problems, including hepatitis virus infection.
- ◆ Tell your healthcare provider about all the medicines you take, including prescription and over-the-counter medicines, antacids, laxatives, vitamins, and herbal supplements. Keep a list of your medicines and show it to your healthcare provider and pharmacist when you get a new medicine.
- Do not start a new medicine without telling your healthcare provider. Your healthcare provider can tell you if it is safe to take BIKTARVY with other medicines. You can ask your healthcare provider or pharmacist for a list of medicines that interact with BIKTARVY.

#### What if I am pregnant or breastfeeding or planning to become pregnant or breastfeed?

- ◆ Tell your healthcare provider if you are pregnant or plan to become pregnant while taking BIKTARVY.
- If you are breastfeeding (nursing) or plan to breastfeed, talk to your healthcare provider about the risks of breastfeeding during treatment with BIKTARVY.
- If you are pregnant and take supplements or antacids that contain aluminum, magnesium, iron, or calcium, talk to your healthcare provider about how to take BIKTARVY along with these supplements or antacids.

#### What should I do if I take too much?

If you take too much BIKTARVY, call your healthcare provider or go to the nearest hospital emergency room right away.

#### What should I do if I run out of medicine?

When your BIKTARVY supply starts to run low, get more from your healthcare provider or pharmacy. This is very important because the amount of virus in your blood may increase if the medicine is stopped even for a short time. The virus may develop resistance to BIKTARVY and become harder to treat.



## There's Only One You, so Prioritize Yourself


With treatment, one of the main goals is getting to and staying undetectable. But it's also important to think about your overall health and wellness.



#### MOST IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT BIKTARVY

#### BIKTARVY may cause serious side effects, including:

 Worsening of hepatitis B (HBV) infection. Your healthcare provider will test you for HBV. If you have both HIV-1 and HBV, your HBV may suddenly get worse if you stop taking BIKTARVY. Do not stop taking BIKTARVY without first talking to your healthcare provider, as they will need to check your health regularly for several months, and may give you HBV medicine.

#### **ABOUT BIKTARVY**

BIKTARVY is a complete, 1-pill, once-a-day prescription medicine used to treat HIV-1 in adults and children who weigh at least 31 pounds. It can either be used in people who have never taken HIV-1 medicines before, or people who are replacing their current HIV-1 medicines and whose healthcare provider determines they meet certain requirements.

**BIKTARVY does not cure HIV-1 or AIDS.** HIV-1 is the virus that causes AIDS.

#### Do NOT take BIKTARVY if you also take a medicine that contains:

- dofetilide
- · rifampin
- · any other medicines to treat HIV-1

#### BEFORE TAKING BIKTARVY

#### Tell your healthcare provider all your medical conditions, including if you:

- Have or have had any kidney or liver problems, including hepatitis infection.
- Are pregnant or plan to become pregnant.
- Are breastfeeding (nursing) or plan to breastfeed.

Tell your healthcare provider right away if you get these symptoms: skin or the white part of your eyes turns yellow, dark "tea-colored" urine, light-colored stools, loss of appetite for several days or longer, nausea, or stomach-area pain.
- The most common side effects of BIKTARVY in clinical studies were diarrhea (6%), nausea (6%), and headache (5%).

These are not all the possible side effects of BIKTARVY. Tell your healthcare provider right away if you have any new symptoms while taking BIKTARVY.

Your healthcare provider will need to do tests to monitor your health before and during treatment with BIKTARVY.

#### **HOW TO TAKE BIKTARVY**

Take BIKTARVY 1 time each day with or without food.
